Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel T. Emmalls forty two Dollars and twenty one cents in account of the expenses of sundry Troopers in escorting arms &c from Eastern by order of the Brigade as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Corkran forty one Dollars and twenty five cents for mounting swords for Captain Woolfords and Captain Hoopers companies as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw twenty six Dollars and eighty cents the amount of his account for nails & furnished the Armourer and five pieces of glass for the Treasury as per account papered and filed.

Thursday July the 16th 1784

The Council met present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond Hester Samuel Hider and Alexander Conlee Magaudee.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John C. Wilson five hundred and three Dollars and ninety eight and one half cents for supplies furnished the Militia of 2^d Regiment on May eight hundred and Thirteen as per account papered and filed.

The Treasurer of the Western Shore authorized to borrow on behalf of the State one hundred and fifty Louisiana Dollars on the terms of the former Loans either from Banks or Individuals.

Walter I Hall James Adams John Mitchell of John Christopher Wilson and Roland Rodger were appointed Justices of the Peace for Harford County and a new commission issued to said County including them.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Lusty twelve Dollars and fifty cents for corn exprest to Daniel Wood as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Lathrop two Dollars for corn exprest to Daniel Wood as per account papered and filed.
