Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Hart one hundred and twenty four Dollars and ten Cents for attending furnishing rations to the guard under the command of Captain Graham as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Z. Kerr twenty eight Dollars and sixty five Cents on account of cash paid by him for Biscuits and a Wagon and for cooking rations for his Company at Saint Michaels on August last as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George W. Smith and John I. Kerr seventeen Dollars and seventy five Cents on account of cash paid by them for cooking for the Militia and for whiskey at Saint Michaels on August last as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Wilmer of Captain Blakes Troop four Dollars for his pay for sixteen days service on August last omitted in muster roll of said Troop as per account paper and filed.

Saided July the 15th 1815

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond, William Samuel Ridout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain George D. Atkinson seventy Dollars the amount of Thomas Kemell and Jacksons bill for Gun Carriages as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isabella Nicholson four Dollars for expess riding to Annapolis for arms and ammunition as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain John Wheeler three Dollars and fifty Cents for three Gallons of whiskey and twenty five gun Flints for the Militia under his command at Cooks point as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the four pieces of Artillery now the property of the Baltimore Volunteer Artillery be purchased for the use of the State at one hundred and fifty Dollars each.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John D. Watkins one hundred Dollars in part of his compensation for making an index to the acts of Assembly.
