

Monday July the 25th 1814

His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Samuel Bidout appeared in the Council room.

The Treasurer of the Western Shore authorized to negotiate a loan of the following Banks on the terms mentioned in their proposals viz^t Merchants Bank of Baltimore twenty thousand Dollars of the City Bank of Baltimore twenty thousand Dollars and of the Marine Bank of Baltimore five thousand Dollars.

Tuesday July 26th 1814

His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Samuel Bidout appeared in the Council room.

Wednesday July 27th 1814

His Excellency the Governor and the honourable William H. Ward and Samuel Bidout appeared in the Council room

The Treasurer of the Western Shore authorized to negotiate a loan in behalf of the State of Maryland with the Farmers Bank of Maryland for fifty thousand Dollars on the terms proposed by the said Bank.

July the 28th and 29th 1814

His Excellency the Governor and the honourable William H. Ward and Samuel Bidout appeared in the Council room

Saturday July the 30th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Clagett paymaster to the 17th Regiment four hundred and fifteen Dollars and fifteen Cents the amount of the following Pay rolls viz^t Captain M^r Eldery for services in June eighteen hundred and fourteen one hundred and ninety five Dollars and seventy four Cents and Captain Coe for services in June eighteen hundred and fourteen two hundred and nineteen Dollars and forty one Cents as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major John H. Anderson seven Dollars and sixty cents by him to Hezekiah Sherry for transporting Pistols from Baltimore to P^rince Georges.
