

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Darnall Contractor for Prince Georges County three hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Quarten Master Thomas Brown three hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Commander be directed to write to J Joseph Henry and inform him that the Executive will take the two hundred and twenty five Iron mounted Muskets now in Baltimore and seven hundred and fifty iron mounted muskets which he has in Philadelphia at thirteen Dollars each to be delivered to Colonel Waters in Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas Brewer paymaster to the 22^d Regiment one hundred and three Dollars and seventy eight Cents amount of pay due the Artillery Company commanded by Captain Wells for services in July Instant as per pay roll.

Marshall Parker was appointed Contractor for Calvert County to find rations at twenty cents for the infantry.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Walter Wilburn twenty Dollars and eighty cents for furnishing one hundred and four rations for a detachment of Militia at Plum Point in August last as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marshall Parker Paymaster to the 31st Regiment forty Dollars and twenty five cents the amount of the following Pay rolls viz^t Captain Leitch's company for nineteen Dollars and ninety three cents and Captain Ireland's for twenty Dollars and thirty two cents for services in August last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marshall Parker Paymaster to the 31st Regiment thirty two Dollars for collecting Pay rolls going to Annapolis and pay one off the Regiment as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marshall Parker Paymaster of the 31st Regiment nine Dollars and sixty three cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Reynolds for services in August last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marshall Parker twenty seven Dollars and five cents for supplies furnished Captain Hall's Troop while on duty in Calvert County in June last as per account paper and filed.
