

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Adam Miller two Dollars and eighteen and an half Cents furnished fatigue guard in September last as per accounts papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gamaliel Taylor Contractor for Anne Arundel and Baltimore Counties five hundred Dollars to be accounted for in supplies for the militia

Tuesday August the 2^d 1814

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H Ward, Thomas G Addison and Samuel Ridout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Lieutenant Colonel William D Prentiss fifteen hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for to purchase supplies for the militia

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Talbot three Dollars and eighty four Cents for horse hire and other expences in going after Deserters in July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John H Black seventeen Dollars and three Cents for Rations furnished the militia stationed at Charles Town in June eighteen hundred and thirteen by order of Lieutenant Colonel William C Miller as per account papered and filed.

Basil Bowring was appointed a Captain Deputy Quartermaster general of the draughted Militia under the requisition of July the fourteenth eighteen hundred and fourteen.

Peregrine Wethered was appointed a Judge of the Levy Court for Kent County vice Samuel Wethered resigned and a new Commission issued to James Bowes, Edward Wright, Edward Embanks, Thomas Hynson, George Hawner, James Buckshank and Peregrine Wethered as Justices of the Levy Court of Kent County.

Ordered that Mr Pinkney direct Colonel Bates to send on to Major James Sewall three hundred weight of grape shot for the use of the Fort at Elkton.

William Bates was appointed a Captain Adjutant general of the draughted militia under the requisition of the fourth of July eighteen hundred and fourteen
