Thursday August the 4th 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Emanuel Dadd eight Dollars and ten Cents in account of supplies furnished a detachment of militia under the Command of Major Higgins as per account passed and filed.

John B. Morris was appointed Division Inspector of the first Division of Maryland Militia.

John Leeds Kerr was appointed Division Inspector of the second Division of Maryland Militia.

John T. Stoddert was appointed Aid de Camp to Brigadier General Philip Stuebel in place of Clement Dessey resigned.

Friday August the 5th 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jehu Chandler three hundred Dollars for one quarters Salary as Printer to the State due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Mitchell Contractor for Kent County two hundred and nine Dollars and fifty five Cents for supplies furnished the militia of said County in July last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Sullivan three Dollars for a fire screen made for the use of the Court of Appeals as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Brigadier General Philip Stuebel two thousand Dollars to purchase militia supplies & to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Beale Ayton fifty Dollars and seventy and a half Cents the balance of his account for Waggon hire in transporting arms &c for the 34th Regiment as per account passed and filed.
