

Saturday August the 20th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governour and the honourable William Bond, Martin, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Rickett.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Elisha Nelson fifty four Dollars for Waggon with Captain Daiseys Company from Frederick as per Account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Scott seven Dollars for his expences in riding Express to General Barrick, Colonel Henk, Colonel Fitzhiman and General Ringgold as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green three Hundred Dollars advanced to him for printing an index to the Laws.

James Boyle was appointed Aid de Camp to Brigadier General Oliver Williams commanding the eighth Brigade of the Militia of the State of Maryland.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Clement Brooke paymaster to the 34th Regiment three hundred and fifty six Dollars and nineteen Cents the amount of three Pay rolls of three Detachments of militia ordered on service under the command of Captain Richard H. Marshall on the eighteenth day of June and the eighth and nineteenth of July last as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Larrimore 400 Dollars for carting Lums from London Town to Big Point for Captain McGenay Company as per Account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Isaac Nicholls forty two Dollars for a Waggon and team accompanying the Militia from Montgomery County to Annapolis as per Account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Hamwood Paymaster to the second Regiment two hundred and twenty seven Dollars and thirteen Cents the amount of eight Payrolls of Captain Simmon's Company for services in April June and July last as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard T. Hall two hundred and eighty one Dollars and sixty Cents for fourteen hundred and eight Rations furnished to the companies commanded by Captains Simons, Tillard, Franklin, and Norman and Lieutenant Estep as per account papered and filed.
