

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Quarter Master Thomas Brown five hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Sullivan four Dollars and sixty six and an half cents for making a Coffin for one of the militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gamaliel Taylor Contract or for Anne Arundell and Baltimore Counties two thousand Dollars for supplies for the militia to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John R. Magruder eleven Dollars for the hire of a Waggon and four Horses and a Cart and oxen to remove the Records from Upper Marlborough to a place of safety as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mary Digges eight Dollars for the hire of a Waggon and horses and cart and oxen to remove the records from Marlborough as per account papered and filed.

John Done was appointed and commissioned Clerk of Somerset County in the place of Josiah Polk dead.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas J. Dorsey one Dollar and fifty cents for expers as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Truman Ramlin eighty Dollars in part of his account for waggon hire as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Colonel Richard Waters Brigade Quarter Master fifteen hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Roderick Dorsey Paymaster to the third Regimental Cavalry District three hundred and thirty two Dollars and forty four cents the amount of pay due a detachment of said Regiment under the command of Lieutenant L Shipley for services in Annapolis in July and August eighteen hundred and sixteen as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Roderick Dorsey paymaster to the third Regimental Cavalry District one hundred and sixty six Dollars and ninety three cents the amount of pay due the Troop of horse commanded by Captain Hamm.
