

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert W. Armstrong one hundred and forty Dollars for services as Brigade Major in May June and August eighteen hundred and thirteen and in July eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to . . . . George Baams forty one Dollars and twenty five cents for services as a Trooper as per account certified by General Forman and papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Hildebrand one hundred and seventy one Dollars in part payment of his account for the hire of his Waggon and team from the 15<sup>th</sup> of July to the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August last inclusive as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to David Chambers one hundred and thirty seven Dollars and seventy five cents for two Waggons and teams employed in removing the Records to the Poplar Springs as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Caswell Drake sixty two Dollars and ninety four cents the amount of his account for the hire of a Waggon and team to remove the records as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to General Philip Stuart one thousand Dollars to purchase supplies for his Brigade to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Caswell Drake thirty four Dollars and fifty cents for two days hire of two Waggons and teams to transport arms &c as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Duke Commissary for the purchase of supplies for the Militia of Calvert County six hundred and fifty Dollars in part of his account papered and filed.

Jonathan Meredith was appointed Inspector of the Third Division of Maryland Militia. Walter Hammond was appointed Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a new commission issued to said County including him.

George Stiles was appointed Captain Joseph Gould 1<sup>st</sup> Lieut Baptist Mezick 2<sup>d</sup> Lieut and Timothy Dimer 3<sup>d</sup> Lieut of an Artillery Company called out for the defence of Baltimore.
