

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nathaniel Brown acting adjutant to the fourth Regiment of Cavalry in General Stuart's Brigade under the general's orders one hundred and forty five Dollars and sixty eight and a half cents for his services from the 13th June 1814 to the 17th of August including rations and compensation for two horses as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters Brigade Quarter Master four hundred and fifty six Dollars on account of three months salary from July 8th 1814 to October 6th and for three months storage as per account papered & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Baer Contractor for Frederick County ~~four~~ hundred and one dollar and twenty cents on account of rations furnished the militia ordered into service by the United States and the State of Maryland as per account papered and filed.

Friday October 14th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable William Bond Martin, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidwell.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Hasket ten Dollars for bullet moulds as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Waters five hundred and sixty nine Dollars and thirty two cents for repairing arms, waggon hire &c. as per account papered and filed.

Jesse S. Taylor was appointed Notary Public for the State of Maryland to reside in Caroline County and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Baer Contractor for Frederick County forty Dollars and fourteen cents for forage furnished the Cavalry his commission thereon and for wood &c. furnished the Militia as per account papered & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Philip Greenwell twenty Dollars for corn furnished Lieutenant Colonel Henry Ashton for the use of his Cavalry as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Richard Clarke twenty two Dollars and fifty cents for the hire of a Horse, cart and Boy employed in collecting provisions for his company and for Gunpowder &c. as per account papered and filed.
