Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benedict Fenwick Quarter Master Sergeant to the fifth Brigade thirty one Dollars and ten cents for services in June July and August last as per payroll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Stephen Gough Brigade Quarter Master to the fifth Brigade one hundred and forty eight Dollars and twenty one cents for services in June July and August last as per payroll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Stephen Gough Brigade Quarter Master to the fifth Brigade three thousand three hundred and twenty one Dollars fourteen and an half cents for Waggon and teams and carts and Oxen employed on the service of the said Brigade as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lewis Williams Quarter Master to the 12th Regiment seventeen Dollars and ninety four cents for Paper Flint Powder Shau and brimstone furnished the said Regiment as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lewis Williams Quarter Master to the 12th Regiment one hundred and three Dollars forty two and an half cents the amount of his account for Artillery horses, carts and teams &c for the use of said Regiment as per account papered and filed.

Saturday October the 15th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honorable William Bond Mantion, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Stephen Gough Brigade Quarter Master to the fifth Brigade seventy nine Dollars sixteen and two third cents the amount of his pay from the 12th of September to the 17th October eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Reym Spinnace fifteen Dollars for three months rent of Magazine from the 19th of July to the 19th of October eighteen hundred and fourteen.
