Doctor Robert R. Newman was appointed Justice of the Peace for Allegany County  
and a new commission issued to said County including him.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Gough Paymaster to the  
12<sup>th</sup> Regiment sixty Dollars and sixty six Cents for his services one month and five days at  
sunday times from Dec<sup>r</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> 1813 to the 28<sup>th</sup> June 1814 and his subsistence as per account papered  
and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor William E Pinkney surgeon  
militia at Annapolis one hundred and fifty Dollars and sixty Cents the balance of his account  
for services from the 13<sup>th</sup> of July to the fifth of October 1814 as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jeremiah Hughes one hundred  
and twenty three Dollars and ninety seven Cents for medicines &c for the Military Hospital  
at Annapolis under the care of Doctor Pinkney in August eighteen hundred and fourteen  
as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Spedden Armourer at  
Easton two hundred and fifty one Dollars and seventy four Cents for one Quarter's salary  
to 1<sup>st</sup> of August last and sundry accounts for work done in the Armoury as per account papered  
and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Ogden six Dollars for  
three days hire of horse cart and Driver for the purpose of conveying Arms &c from Port-  
Tobacco to the encampment of the Militia at Bladensburg Maryland County as per account  
papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Ogden four Dollars for  
conveying ammunition cartridge Boxes &c from Port Tobacco to the encampment of the Militia  
at Charlotte Hall in Saint Marys County as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Walter Sciggins twelve Dollars for a  
cart and two yoke of oxen Driver and himself for seven days in July last in hauling Artillery pieces  
small arms ammunition &c from Port Tobacco Warehouse to Port Tobacco Town and from said Town  
to New Town as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Bonwell two Dollars &  
twenty five Cents for seven days service in Hugh Cox's company on duty last and for two rations  
as per account papered and filed which was omitted on the payroll.
