

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas Brewer Paymaster to the 22^d Reg^t one hundred and eighty nine Dollars and sixty nine cents to pay a detachment of Captain Hatherley's company ordered into service by the Governor for the defence of the Magazine, as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Charles H. Bryan eight Dollars paid by him for the transportation of a field piece with ammunition from Annapolis to Cambridge as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lawrence Posey forty one Dollars for rations furnished in June last and for the service of a Waggon and two horses for eleven days as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Smith Quarter Master to the 21st Regiment two hundred and sixteen Dollars fifty one and an half cents for supplies furnished said Regiment and for his expences in travelling to and from Annapolis to settle his accounts as per Accounts no 1.2.3&4 papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Blagell Paymaster to the 17th Regiment six hundred and twenty four Dollars and seventy five cents the amount of the following Pay rolls to wit Captain John R. Dyer's company for services in June last fifty seven Dollars and forty one cents, Samuel Cox for services in July and August last three hundred Dollars and thirty seven cents, Horatio Blagell for services in July last one hundred and fifty seven Dollars and seventy seven cents and Captain Dyer for services in July last one hundred and nine Dollars and forty cents as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jos. Morris Paymaster to the 25th Reg^t one hundred and eighty five Dollars and seventy two cents the amount of Pay due the company commanded by Captain Levin Ballard for services in May last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Charles H. Bryan ninety eight Dollars and seventy two cents the amount of pay due the Artillery company commanded by him for services in July last as per pay roll.
