Tuesday November the 8<sup>th</sup> 1816

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marsham Parker Contractor for Calvert County two hundred Dollars in part of his account to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George D. Parmham Paymaster to the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment two thousand two hundred and fifty one Dollars and forty four Cents the amount of the following Pay rolls to wit. Captain Parmham nine Dollars and ninety six Cents, Captain Parmham for services in July last one hundred and forty five Dollars and forty four Cents, Captain John B. Hingerford for services in July and August last four hundred and twenty three Dollars and nine Cents, Lawrence Posey for services in June last one hundred and eighty five Dollars and seventy nine Cents, Captain Edelen for services in July last fourteen Dollars and sixty seven Cents, Alexander Dent one hundred and forty Dollars and sixty six Cents, Gardiners one hundred and sixty one Dollars and ninety six Cents, Middleton's Twenty four Dollars and forty three Cents, Cox's four hundred and thirty six Dollars and twenty six Cents, Dent's two hundred and sixty two Dollars and sixty four Cents, Dent's forty three Dollars and seventy six Cents, Gardiners thirty three Dollars and ninety five Cents, Lieut Gardiners one hundred and eight Dollars and ninety four Cents and John Matthews for services in June July and August last two hundred and fifty seven Dollars and eighty nine Cents as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major John Matthews fifty five Dollars and fifty four Cents pay due him for services in July last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Luke Matthews sixty nine Dollars and ninety one Cents for pay due him for services in June and July last as per pay rolls no 1 and 2.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George D. Parmham Paymaster to the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment forty three Dollars and ten Cents pay due him for services from the 29<sup>th</sup> July to the 10<sup>th</sup> of October as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters Brigadier General one hundred and twenty five Dollars and ninety six Cents the
