The Council met present his excellency the Governor and the honourable William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Philip Hammond twenty seven Dollars and fifty cents for rations furnished the Militia under the command of Captain Hester in August last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Clement Brooke Paymaster to the Thirty fourth Regiment twenty Dollars for services in June and July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr Susan Wygill forty five Dollars and eighteen cents for the use of her house as a hospital for the Militia in the months of August, September and October last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George D Parrham Paymaster to the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment three hundred and three Dollars and sixty nine cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain James A. Middleton for services in June last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to J. H. Hall one hundred and twenty nine Dollars and fifty cents for transporting arms, riding express, the hire of his waggons, in June, July and August last as per accounts 1 & 2 papered and filed.

Ordered that Mr Shaw direct Mr Henry to send on to William H. Ward esquire at Elkton Cecil County sixty Rifles, ten of them to be long Rifles and fifty of them to be short with maple stocks.
