

Ordered that the foregoing Proclamation be published for five weeks in the Maryland Gazette, Federal Republican, Spirit of '76, Frederick Town Herald, Plain Dealer Federal Gazette, Telegraph, Hagar's Town Gazette, Peoples Monitor and Browns Paper Cumberland.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to W. H. Fitzhugh sixty Dollars and fifty Cents for the hire of two horses for the Artillery in Calvert County in July and August last by order of Colonel Tamey as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Harty three Dollars and fifty Cents for transporting a piece of Artillery, his expences in going to Annapolis with R. Shave, and from thence to Baltimore and for rations furnished the Militia in June last as per accounts nos 1 & 2 & 3 papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward More twelve Dollars for six Sheep furnished the Militia in July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jas Wilkinson twelve Dollars and ten Cents for Bacon furnished for the Militia under the commands of Colonel Tamey in July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Alexander H. Maguder twenty Dollars for a Horse which died in the service of the State as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major W. L. Wiems nine Dollars and fifty Cents for Bacon and Meal furnished the Militia at Hunting Town and Holland Bluffs as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Abraham Lowe twenty seven Dollars for rations furnished the Militia at Plum Point in April eighteen hundred and sixteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to W. H. Fitzhugh eight Dollars for riding expens from Colonel Tamey to Annapolis as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas W. Harris thirty three Dollars and eighty four Cents for provisions furnished the Militia in July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Clare three Dollars for removing a piece of Artillery as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Haewood Paymaster to the Militia twenty two Dollars for one months pay in July and August last.
