

Friday December 2<sup>d</sup> 1816

The Council met. Present the honourable William Bond Martin Samuel Bidout and Alexander Coute Maguideo.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marsham Parker Paymaster to the 31<sup>st</sup> Regiment; one thousand five hundred and six Dollars and seventy cents the amount of the following pay rolls to wit. Captain Joseph Griffiths No 1245 two hundred and fifty nine Dollars and thirty cents; Ensign Harris's No 132 fifty four Dollars and twenty two cents; Captain Chew No 1243 one hundred and twenty nine Dollars and thirty one cents; Captain Gray twenty nine Dollars and fifty three cents; Captain Ireland two hundred and twelve Dollars and ninety four cents; Ensign Marshall's twenty Dollars and thirty four cents; Captain Hilkey Wilsons no 132 one hundred and forty five Dollars and ninety three cents; Ensign Clares No 132 two hundred and forty eight Dollars and thirty six cents; Lieutenant Lovielles twenty eight Dollars and nineteen cents; Lieutenant Ireland sixty four Dollars and fifty five cents; Major Johns one hundred and thirty two Dollars and ninety four cents; Major Wams one hundred and thirteen Dollars and seventy two cents; and Adjutant King No 132 sixty seven Dollars and thirty eight cents for services in June and July last as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marsham Parker Paymaster of the 31<sup>st</sup> Regiment three hundred and twenty five Dollars in part payment of his account to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Cameron forty Dollars in part of his account for going to Philadelphia for the purpose of bringing John Marshall a fugitive from justice to Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Thomas forty four Dollars and forty four cents for services in June last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Clement Brooke Paymaster to the 31<sup>st</sup> Regiment eighty five Dollars and thirty nine cents for pay of a detachment of Militia under the command of Captain Jones as per pay roll for services in July last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John J. Donaldson Paymaster to the second Regimental Cavalry District seven hundred and sixty four Dollars and seventy six cents the amount of Captain John E. Herberts pay rolls No 132 for services in June July and August last as per pay rolls.
