Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lewis Hedley Contractor of Saint Marys County three hundred and fifty six Dollars and five cents for rations and grass furnished the militia in June and July last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John D. Welch six Dollars and seventy two cents for militia services in August last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Cameron one hundred and sixty two Dollars the balance of his account for bringing John Marshall a fugitive from justice from Philadelphia to Baltimore as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry H. Harwood twenty two Dollars twelve and an half cents being the amount paid by him to Joseph West for the hire of a waggon to remove the public property from Annapolis to Frederick Town as per receipt filed.
