

Thursday December the 13 1812

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Alexander Lee, Mayor of Fredericksburg, the Honorable John Addison and Samuel Rident.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Blagett Surgeon to the 11th Regiment one thousand two hundred and sixty seven Dollars and forty one Cents the account of the following day bills to Capt. W. Hedges for services in June and August twenty four Dollars and thirty three Cents, Captain Barnes for services in June July and August two hundred and twenty seven Dollars and sixty six Cents, Captain Taylors for services in June July and August four hundred and ten Dollars and eighty nine Cents, Captain W. Eldey for services in July and August three hundred and thirty three Dollars and twenty seven Cents, and Doctor Lee for services in July and August twenty two Dollars and seventy six Cents as per pay roll paper.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Heems ten Dollars for hiring Tent and Tent Poles from Plumbe point to Hunting Town and for House Rent for the purpose of keeping provisions at Plumbe point and Hunting Town in June last as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Heems eleven Dollars and twenty five Cents for riding express from Colonel Torrey to Annapolis in June last as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Heems five Dollars and eighty six Cents for Bacon Oats & furnished the Militia of Calvert County in July last as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Heems four hundred and forty five Dollars for the hire of a Waggon from Warrenton and driver from the month of June to the fifth of September eighteen hundred and fourteen for the use of the 31st Regiment of Maryland militia as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Josiah McCawley Thirty Dollars, ninety six and an half Cents for supplies furnished a Detachment of Hays Bridgely's Battalion under the command of Captain Wanfield and Lieutenant Curran as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Charles S. Hodge, Jr. One hundred and one Dollars and fifteen Cents as per account paid and filed.
