

Thursday December the 15th 1781

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honorable Alexander M'Gregor, Thomas G. Jackson and Samuel M'Intosh.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Blagell Paymaster to the 31st Regiment one thousand two hundred and sixty seven Dollars and forty one Cents the amount of the following Pay rolls to wit. V^o Hedges for services in June and August seventy four Dollars and thirty three Cents. Captain Baxes for services in June July and August two hundred and twenty seven Dollars and sixty six Cents. Captain Maylers for services in June July and August four hundred and ten Dollars and eighty nine Cents. Captain W^o Elderji for services in July and August three hundred and thirty three Dollars and seventy seven Cents. and Doctor Lee for services in July and August twenty Dollars and seventy six Cents as per pay rolls papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Steens ten Dollars for hauling Tents and Tent Poles from Clumb point to Hunting Town and for House rent for the purpose of keeping provisions at Clumb Point and Hunting Town in June last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Steens eleven Dollars and twenty five Cents for carrying express from Colonel Taney to Annapolis in June last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Steens five Dollars and eighty six Cents for Bacon Dabs furnished the Militia of Calvert County in July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gustavus Steens four hundred and forty five Dollars for the hire of a Waggon four Horses and driver from the South of June to the fifth of September eighteen hundred and fourteen for the use of the 31st Regiment of Maryland militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John M'Conroy thirty Dollars ninety six and an half Cents for supplies furnished a Detachment of Major Hedges's Regiment under the command of Captain Warfield and Lieutenant Curran as per account papered and filed.
