

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Patrick Dixon two hundred and eighty eight Dollars and twenty two cents for hire of a Wagon and Driver from the 20th July to the 19th of September last inclusive as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Patrick Dixon eighty two Dollars and twenty cents for a Cart two horses and a Driver from the 15th of June to the 15th July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Darwell Contractor three hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Heine Junior Surgeon to the 26th Regiment sixteen Dollars and eighty four cents the amount of pay due him for services in October and November last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas M. Dawson six Dollars and fifty two and an half cents for expenses furnished the twenty sixth Regiment in October last as per account papered and filed.

Sunday December 19th 1814

The Honorable William H. Ward Counselor at Law appeared in the Council room and qualified as a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking the several oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and Laws of this State and by making and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion and also in taking the oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Alexander Cortee Maquire, William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel C. Beckett.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Quarter Master Thomas Brown one thousand and twenty nine Dollars and fifty five cents the balance of his account as per account papered and filed.

Sunday December the 25th 1814

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Alexander Cortee Maquire, William H. Ward, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel C. Beckett.

John Young was appointed Register of Wills for Caroline County on the joint recommendations of the two Houses of the Legislature and Commissioned to him accordingly.
