

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Harrison one hundred and fifty Dollars for services in the Council Chamber and at the Capitol Springs from the 20th of August to the 20th of November last as per account papered and filed.

The Council returned the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and laws to be appointed annually and did not having come to a resolution postponed the further consideration thereof till tomorrow.
