

From Saturday the 24th to Wednesday the 28th of December inclusive his Excellency the Governor and the honourable Alexander Contee Magruder and Samuel Bidout appeared in the Council room.

Thursday December the 29th 1814

The honourable John Mianaw Councilor elect appeared in the Council room and qualified before Louis Gaspary esquire a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking the several oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and laws of this state and by making and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion and also by taking the oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable Alexander Contee Magruder, Samuel Bidout and John Mianaw.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Meredith Militia accountant at Easton one hundred and thirty Dollars for salary & perquisites as per account papered & filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Bennett Braeco Paymaster to the 26th Regiment three hundred and fifty eight Dollars and sixty six Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Kings for services from April till September last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel L. Dickinson Quarter Master to the 4th Regiment fourteen Dollars and eighty two Cents for supplies furnished the militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John C. Wilson Junior Quarter Master to the 23rd Regiment five hundred and ninety eight Dollars and seven Cents for rations for rations furnished the militia in April last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay ~~Capt~~ George D. Atkinson one hundred and twenty Dollars and eighty Cents the amount of pay due the Artillery Company commanded by him for services in April last as per pay roll.

Lenox Macton, Thomas Thistle and John Scott were appointed Justices of the Orphan Court of Allegany County and commission issued to them accordingly.

Joseph Chesap, William Shaw, John Tomlinson, David Hoffman Senior, James Tetta, James Paather Junior and John Folke were appointed Justices of the Levy Court of Allegany County and commission issued to them accordingly.
