George W. Jackson, John Brownlow, William Standy Senior, Daniel Ballard, John Hopkins of Collier, William Beach and Robert Leatherbury were appointed and commissioned Justices of the Peace Court of Somerset County.

William Denson, John Stewart and Peter Dashell were appointed and commissioned Justices of the Orphans Court for Somerset County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William B. Barnes seven Dollars for the hire of boats employed in removing the Public Records and papers from Upper Marlboro on time last as per account passed and filed.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of Annual appointment till tomorrow.

Wednesday January 4<sup>th</sup> 1815

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Alexander Conlee Kingander, Samuel Pinout and John Murray.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Hammond Paymaster to the 2<sup>d</sup> Regiment one hundred and forty five Dollars and seventy one Cents the amount of his account my bill to wit Captain Tilands number one seventy eight Dollars and sixty four Cents, ditto number two forty three Dollars and eighty seven Cents, ditto number three seven Dollars and twenty four Cents, ditto number four fifteen Dollars and forty six Cents as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Pontney Cashier of the Faivers Bank of Maryland four thousand Dollars advanced to Joseph Mitchell Esq; and his wife in Kent to be laid to his account.
