burns of Collier, William Roach and Robert Leatherbury were appointed and commis-
sioned Justices of the Peace Court of Somerset County.

Lindson Dumas, John Stewart and Peter Dashiell were appointed and commis-
sioned Justices of the Orphans Court for Somerset County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William B. Beames seven
Dollars for the hire of boats employed in removing the Public Records and papers from
Upper Marlboro in June last as per account papered and filed.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other
officers of Annual appointment till tomorrow.

Wednesday January 4th 1815

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Alex-
ander Contee Magawder, Samuel Ridout and John Murray.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Harwood Paym-
aster to the 2^d Regiment one hundred and forty five Dollars and seventy one Cents the
Amount of the following Pay rolls to wit. Captain Richards number one seventy eight
Dollars and sixty four Cents, ditto number two forty three Dollars and eighty seven
Cents, ditto number three seven Dollars and seventy four Cents, ditto number four
fifteen Dollars and forty six Cents as per pay rolls.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Pinkney Cash-
ier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland four thousand Dollars advanced to Joseph Mitchell
Commodore of the Ship in Kent to be to said Mitchell accounted for.
