Wednesday January the 11th 1815

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Alexander Coote Maguire, Samuel Bidart and John Murray.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Crane Paymaster to the 2^d Regiment five hundred and six Dollars and nine Cents the amount of the following Pay rolls to wit. Captain Chambers for services in December last one hundred and four Dollars and fifty one Cents, Captain Hynson for services in December last fifty Dollars and thirty Cents, Lieutenant Tilghman for services in December last sixty one Dollars and thirty nine Cents, Captain Wickes for services in December last sixty seven Dollars and seventy nine Cents, Captain Pagar for services in December last one hundred and three Dollars and six Cents, Field and Staff officers for services in December last one hundred and nineteen Dollars and four Cents as per pay rolls papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Harris four Dollars for transportation of a piece of artillery for the use of the Artillery Company attached to Colonel Browns Regiment as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Crane Paymaster to the 2^d Regiment thirty nine Dollars for coming to Annapolis to paper pay rolls as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Barwood Paymaster to the 2^d Regiment one hundred and sixty nine Dollars and forty eight Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Belmont for services in August last as per pay roll papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Stacy A. Clarke Sergeant Major of the 24th Regiment six Dollars and thirteen Cents for his services in July last as per account papered and filed.
