Saturday January the 14<sup>th</sup> 1815

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable  
Alexander Contee, Magruder, Samuel Bidout and John Munnay.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Wilkinson nine  
Dollars and eighty seven and one half cents for corn furnished Captain Hall's  
troop of Horse as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Gray six Dollars  
for six hundred weight of clover hay furnished to Captain Hall's troop of Horse  
as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Harwood
