Tuesday February the 14th 1815

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Alexander Magruder, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Rodenick Dorsey Paymaster to the 3rd Regimental Cavalry District three hundred and thirteen Dollars and ninety six cents the amount of pay due the Troop commanded by Captain Mackall for services in June and July last as per pay roll papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marsham Parker Paymaster to the 31st Regiment six hundred and sixty Dollars and seventeen cents the amount of the following Pay rolls to wit. Captain Ben Leitch's two hundred and forty one Dollars and forty nine cents, Captain B. Gray's one hundred and seventy nine Dollars and eighty two cents, and Surgeon M. Harris's two hundred and thirty eight Dollars and eighty six cents for services in June, July and August last as per pay rolls papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Sampson Thomas ninety Dollars for mounting two pieces of Artillery by order of General Stuart as per acco.
