That he appears to have acted from as the court considered an erroneous construction of the act of Assembly and not from any corrupt or improper motive. That it would not have imposed the said fine on the said Purviance if it had had any discretion. The Board on the consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said fine

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Holliday Paymaster Alexander Contee Magaudee to the 9<sup>th</sup> Regimental Cavalry \$1630.17<sup>cts</sup> the amount of pay due Lieut Raymond's Troop of Horse for services in Talbot County in 1814

By the Petition of Josiah Polk of Somerset County accompanied by a Transcript from the proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by the said Court at September term eighteen hundred and fourteen the sum of two Hundred Dollars for an assault and battery on the body of Winder Bailey. The Board on the consideration of the circumstances of the case and from the recommendation of the honourable William Whittington a Justice of the said Court together with a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the said County do remit one hundred and fifty Dollars of the said fine.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Holliday two hundred and forty five Dollars and nineteen cents pay due Lieut Harrison's Troop of Horse for services in Talbot County in October 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Alexander Contee Magaudee, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Sarah Pop six Dollars for attending the sick at the Hospital and scouring the rooms as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John N. Watkins for making an index to the Laws and Resolutions six hundred Dollars in addition to the one hundred Dollars for which an order was given before.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Quarter Master Thomas six hundred and thirty six Dollars for his pay from the sixteenth of Decem.
