John Withers was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Somerset County and com-  
mission issued to said Court by including them.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to David S. Huntington eight  
Dollars for the hire of a Wagon and team part of the year from the 1st of January  
to the 1st of August as per account paper and filed.

Friday Feb. 11th 1785

The Council met present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Alex-  
ander Conrad Maan del. Thomas G. Anderson and Samuel Stewart.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant James Paymaster  
to the 32<sup>d</sup> Regiment of the Continental Army eight hundred and thirty one Dollars and one Cent the  
amount of pay due the company commanded by Captain Smith for services in June  
and July last as per pay roll paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant James Paymaster  
to the 32<sup>d</sup> Regiment six hundred and ninety two Dollars and four Cents the amount  
of pay due the company commanded by Captain Smith for services in July and  
August last as per pay roll paper and filed.
