

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Charles Holland seventeen Shillings and six Pence for sweeping chimnies as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James L. Lambden Paymaster to the 6th Regiment twenty two Dollars and sixty one Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Newman for services in October last as per pay roll papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Robert Nichols seventy Dollars and fifty Cents for rent of Rooms for Records as per account papered and filed.

Joseph M. Cromwell was appointed Sheriff of Frederick County in the place of M. Jones deceased the second on the return having declined.

Otho Sprigg was appointed Justice of the Levy Court of Frederick County and commission issued to James Johnson, Alexander Warfield of Charles, Benjamin Bigg, Stephen Steimer, James Morrison, John McKelip and Otho Sprigg as Justices of the Levy Court of Frederick County.

Thomas Bafford and William Hall were appointed Justices of the Peace of Anne Arundel County and a new commission issued to said County including them and leaving out Nicholas J. Watkins.

Thomas C. Carle was appointed Register of Wills for Queen Annes County in the place of William H. Nicholson deceased to hold the said office till the next meeting of the Legislature.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas G. Addison five Dollars paid by him to Thomas Hodges who was employed in procuring Waggon for the removal of Records as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Hodges of Thomas thirty two Dollars and fifty Cents for the hire of a Cart, man and two Horses in the employ of Major Biscoes Battalion for thirteen days for the use of the State in July and August eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Hodges of Thomas five Dollars for delivering an express from Major Biscoe to Governor Winder for arms and attending the same to upper Marlborough as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Hodges of Thomas ninety Dollars for Bacon, Whiskey, one ditch oven and one pot furnished for the use of the militia of Prince Georges County as per account papered and filed.
