Thursday May the 4<sup>th</sup> 1815

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Thomas G. Addison, Samuel Ridout and John Munnay.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Coote a hundred and eight Dollars and twenty five Cents the balance of his account for bringing records from the white house and Prince George to Annapolis including his wages & M. to the 24<sup>th</sup> of March as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor William Brewer surgeon to the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment twenty Dollars and fifty five and one half Cents for services at Annapolis in August last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Birch five Dollars and seventy six Cents for guarding Public Records as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant Richard Gott of the 3<sup>d</sup> Regiment eighteen Dollars and twenty Cents for services at Annapolis in August last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Nicholls fourteen Dollars and eighty six and one half Cents for straw and wood furnished the guard under his command at the Magazine as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Sergeant Samuel Nicholls seven and nine Dollars and ten Cents the amount of pay due a detachment of Militia in
