

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Stewart five Dollars for proving and examining sundry Muskets by order of the Governor as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to J. Joseph Henny six thousand five hundred and fifty seven Dollars and thirty five cents for four hundred and twenty muskets and forty Rifles purchased of him for the use of the state as per account papered and filed.

William Brown was appointed Examiner General of the State of Maryland vice John Hatherly deceased and Commission issued to him accordingly.

The Clerk of the Council requested to enquire of the Printer to the State whether he intends to print the laws of the last Session.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William G. Waters Paymaster to the 23^d Regiment five hundred and sixty one Dollars and eighty two cents the amount of the following Pay rolls to wit. Captain Whittington Polles for services in April and May eighteen hundred and fourteen as per pay rolls No 142 two hundred and fifty three Dollars and thirty one cents. Captain Whites for services in May and June last one hundred and thirty nine Dollars and eighteen cents. Captain William King for services in April eighteen hundred and fourteen one hundred and thirty four Dollars and seventy five cents. and Lieutenant James Tilghman for services in May last thirty four Dollars and fifty eight cents as per pay rolls papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Cartwell two Dollars for cleaning and putting in order thirty five Muskets and Bayonets as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Bauff thirteen Dollars and fifty six cents for cleaning sixty two stands of Arms as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Heming ten Dollars for seven day hire of his Horse and Cart to convey arms ammunition and baggage from Princeps Anne with troops commanded by Captain Heath as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William White six Dollars for hire of his Horse and Cart employed in carrying arms and provisions for the
