

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Meredith Militia account and for the Eastern Shore one hundred and twenty eight Dollars and forty five and an half cents for one Quarters salary and amount of expences as per account passed & filed.

Ordered that the Order of the Council of the 5th of May last directing suits to be instituted against William Chambers and his securities be suspended and suits not to be brought upon said Chambers and his securities giving Bond for payment of the sum ascertained to be due by him to the State payable in eight sixteen and twenty four months. On the application of Samuel Miller of Cecil County for the preference in the purchase of the following tract or parcel of Land lying and being in new conmaught Manor in Cecil County covered by a writ of Ad quod damnum a lease from Benjamin Taster agent of Lord Baltimore to Thomas Miller beginning for the same at a marked ash tree designated on the plate by the Red letter A. said tree stands on the East brink or bank of principio Creek it being a boundary tree of said John Camerons land and running thence with said land the following courses and distances, To wit; south forty three degrees and thirty minutes east sixty four Perches to a black oak stump a boundary of said land, thence south forty five degrees and thirty minutes east forty nine Perches and three fourths of a Perch to a white oak stump another Boundary of said land, thence south twenty six degrees and thirty minutes East twenty Perches to a large white Oak tree another boundary of said Camerons land, thence south twelve degrees and thirty minutes East twenty Perches and eight tenths to a beach tree marked with twelve notches standing on the East bank or brink of said creek being also a corner tree of Richard Bookings land thence running on said land the following courses, to wit; south fifty four degrees west twenty three Perches and five tenths to a post on the south side of said creek thence North fifty one degrees west eighteen Perches to a Post, thence North sixty degrees and thirty minutes west twenty one Perches to a large Poplar tree a boundary of said land, and also the beginning tree of a tract of land belonging to the said Samuel Miller, called and known by the name of Steelmans delight, thence by the last or home line of Steelmans delight reversed North three degrees and thirty minutes West seventy three Perches to a post at the end of the third line of Steelmans delight, thence by the said third line reversed, North seven degrees and thirty minutes West sixty Perches to a Post set in said line a corner of Thomas Wilsons land.
