By the Petition of John Hughes accompanied by a Transcript from the proceedings of the Court of Frederick County, it appears that he was fined by the said Court at February term eighteen hundred and fifteen in two cases the sum of six Pounds current money in each case for selling spirituous liquors without licence. The Petitioner states that he had no intention of violating the law or of defrauding the state. That at February term before he was presented (which was the term at which he usually took a licence for the whole year) he was sick and unable to attend. That he applied to Richard Brooke esquire to procure a licence for him in the name of the Court to retail spirituous liquors until the August term following. That he was under the impression that such a licence had been obtained and between the February and August term of said Court called on Roger Nelson esquire one of the Judges of the Court and paid into his hands the sum of five Dollars which he then understood was the cost of licence from February until August but that the said Roger Nelson told him that as the offences for which he was presented had been previously committed such payment would not avail him on a presentment for selling spirituous liquors; but that he would receive the money and if the fines should be remitted would apply it in payment for his licence for the period aforesaid. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fines of six Pounds current money each.
