derive clear of Elder surveys the quantity one hundred and ten acres and one half acre  
of land. The Council agreed to sell the States right to said land to the said Henry Bama  
for the sum of one Dollar per acre.

Ordered that the suit against William Chambers late Treasurer of the Eastern Shore  
be suspended in consideration of his acknowledgment of his debt of three thousand and  
twenty five Dollars and sixty one cents to the State of Maryland.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Pyle two hundred  
Dollars for provisions and quarters furnished the Cavalry under the command of Major  
Cook in August last as per account and vouchers papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Pop thirty three Dollars  
and two and an half cents for provisions furnished the troops under the command  
of Captain Thomas Vinson on the fifth of August last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John S. Hall eleven Dollars  
and twelve and an half cents for provisions furnished the company under the command  
of Captain Rohrer on their march to Annapolis in July eighteen hundred and fourteen  
as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Wager seventeen Dollars  
for provisions furnished the draughted Militia under the command of Captains Wharrel  
and Miller on their march to Baltimore in May eighteen hundred and thirteen as per  
account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Mumroe one hundred and  
forty four Dollars and thirteen cents for portages for the State as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Johnson fifteen Dollars  
for riding expere as per account papered and filed.
