

The Council proceeded to elect an associate Judge for the first Judicial District to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of Daniel Clarke Esquire the Ballots being deposited in the Ballot Box on the examination thereof it appeared that John Rowsby Plater Esquire was elected whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said John Rowsby Plater is duly elected associate Judge of the first Judicial District of Maryland. Ordered that Commission issue. Commission issued to him accordingly.

Whereas by an Inquisition held on the body of a certain Amos Gambrell it was found that the said Amos Gambrell was murdered by a certain Henry H. Brown and it has been represented to me that the said Henry H. Brown has fled from justice and it being of the greatest importance to society that the perpetrator of such a crime should be brought to condign punishment. I have therefore thought proper to issue this my Proclamation and do by and with the advice and consent of the Council offer a reward of two Hundred Dollars to any person who shall apprehend and deliver the said Henry H. Brown to the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County. Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this twenty second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
