From Monday the 2^d to Saturday the 7th of October 1815 the honourable Alexander Contee Magaudee and Samuel Ridout appeared in the Council Room.

The Council met. Present the honourable Alexander Contee Magaudee William M. Ward and Samuel Ridout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw two hundred and forty two Dollars and fifty cents for binding Records in the Land office, directed by the legislature, and for articles furnished to the Executive as per account papered and filed.
