

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick Sholl m^r 7 Dollars and twenty seven cents for provisions furnished the Cavalry under the command of Major Cook and Williams in August 1814 as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that Colonel Richard Waters Brigade Quarter Master be requested to sell the Blankets belonging to the State.

Ordered that M^r Shaw be requested to have the Pillars of the outward door of the Stadt House and the terrace repaired immediately.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Hugh Cox forty three Dollars and forty two and an half cents for rations furnished his Company of Draughted Militia in April eighteen hundred and thirteen and for cash paid for sundry articles to make cartouch Boxes &c. as per account papered and filed.
