Ordered that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaiah Nichols one hundred and thirteen Dollars and twenty eight cents the amount of the following accounts for supplies furnished Captain Vinsans Company on their march to Annapolis in August eighteen hundred and fourteen to wit Isaiah Nichols eighteen Dollars and forty cents, John Lodge twenty eight Dollars and ninety five cents, Enoch Brunans four Dollars and fifty cents, William Chevills two Dollars and twenty five cents, Thomas Magniders one Dollar and fifty cents, Thomas Getting six Dollars, William Darrons thirty nine Dollars and twenty five cents and George P.
