

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John L. Phelps forty seven Dollars and seventy five cents for unbreeching and altering one hundred stand of arms and for coming to Annapolis for swords as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Dawson ten Dollars for one Quarters half pay due the first of November last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Bruff sixty Dollars for one Quarters half pay due the first of November last.

By the Petition of Fielder Berry of Charles County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he entered into two Recognizances with Samuel Berry his security in the sum of twenty Pounds current money in each case for his appearance at August term eighteen hundred and fourteen to answer Presentments and so forth. The Petitioner states that he did attend at said term and offered himself ready for trial, but that the said cases were put off in consequence of the state not being ready for trial. That it was his intention to appear at March Term eighteen hundred and fifteen (at which time the said Recognizances were declared to be forfeited) but that the Court adjourned sooner than he expected and before he got there. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said Recognizances

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable Alexander C. Magruder, Samuel Bidout and John Murray
