By the Petition of Frederick Williamson it appears that he was fined by the Court of Bye and Termine and Gaol delivery for Baltimore County at August Term eighteen hundred and fifteen on three cases for selling spirituous liquors without license. The Petitioner states that he was under Commodore Barney at Washington and assisted in defending the Capital. That he lost one arm and was afterwards much injured. That after he recovered from his wounds he went to Baltimore and rented a small house and set up a shop which was the only mode by which he could obtain a subsistence. That a woman whose child he boarded and whom he was obliged to maintain for the board presented him for selling spirituous liquors without license. He admits that he sold the liquors to the Prosecutor, but declares that he did not know that it was illegal for him so to do and that he is unable to pay the fines. The Board on consideration of the circumstances of the case and from the recommendation of the said Court do remit the said fines
