Thursday January the 11th 1815

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Alex-
ander C. Maguire James Shaw and William H. Wand.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Thomas Surgeon
to the 12th Regiment one hundred and twenty three Dollars and eighty six cents for
his pay for services in eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Raphael Coombs Quarters
Master Sergeant to 12th Regiment one Dollar and thirty eight cents for his pay for
services in eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John J. Hillen one
hundred and ninety one Dollars and thirty eight cents for his pay as Quarters
Master in eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lewis Williams
