Abraham Sannett, Thomas S. Bond, Henry M'Attee, Isaac Hollingsworth, Joseph Robinson of Bellear, Reuben Stump of Belleau and Robert Morgan of Edward were appointed Justices of the Levy Court of Harford County and Commission issued accordingly.

James Wallace, John S. Webster and John Norris of Edward were appointed Justices of the Orphan Court for Harford County and Commission issued accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Simmons Quarter Master to the 31st Regiment eighteen Dollars and ninety six cents for services on eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.
