William Strett was appointed Notary Public for the State of Maryland to reside at the City of Baltimore in the place of Samuel Strett resigned and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Ogden ninety seven Dollars for boarding and attending on Charles Garner wounded in the service of the State on July eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore Pay to Doctor Thomas J. Speake seventy five Dollars and twenty five cents for medical aid rendered Charles Garner wounded in the service of the State as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Woods seventy nine cents for bandages for Charles Garner wounded in the service of the State on July eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green esquire two hundred Dollars for publishing the bill for regulating and disciplining the Militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nathaniel P. Gauson Secours partner of Gauson & Hamson twenty Dollars and fifty four cents for medical aid rendered Charles Garner wounded in the service of the State as per account papered and filed.
