Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw thirty eight Dollars and ninety three cents the amount of an order in his favour drawn by William Ross late Armorer at Annapolis to be deducted from the balance ascertained to be due him by a settlement of his account this day as per order filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Ross late Armorer at Annapolis five hundred and fifty Dollars the balance due him by a settlement in full this day as per statement made and filed.
