Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William S. Morrell thirty five Dollars and thirty four cents for Forage and Rations furnished the troops under the command of Colonel Tamey as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Lewis Duwall fifty Dollars and fifty cents for forage and Rations furnished Captain Hall's Troop in eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James M. Lambdin, forty Dollars for his services as Paymaster as per account papered and filed.

Stephen Latimer, John Estep and Gustavus Gill were appointed Justices of the Peace for Charles County and a new commission issued to said County including them and leaving out Walter Dyson deceased.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lewis Phillips four Dollars and fifty cents for the use of his cart and oxen in carrying provisions to a Guard on <sup>Monday</sup> week in Duchester County as per account papered and filed.
