Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William D. Beall Editor of the Hager Town Gazette one hundred and eighty eight Dollars and twenty five Cents for publishing Militia Lists as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Smith Quarter Master to the 21<sup>st</sup> Regiment fifty seven Dollars and seventy cents the amount of the following accounts heretofore postponed to wit. William Crane twelve Dollars, Richard Coleby six Dollars, Robert Cooper fourteen Dollars, Thomas Hannis eight Dollars and seventy cents, Thomas Branch, six Dollars, James Baden six Dollars, and John Humphreys seven Dollars for House Rent for Militia of said Regiment as per accounts papered and filed with Thomas Smiths last general account papered 5<sup>th</sup> of January eighteen hundred and fifteen.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Gustavus W. Wight fifty Three Dollars and fifty eight cents the amount of pay due him for services as Capt<sup>n</sup> of an Artillery Company from August eighteenth hundred and thirteen as per pay roll papered.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Houston thirty six Dollars and forty cents for his Cart, Driver and three horses employed by the Militia from the 13<sup>th</sup> of August to the 25<sup>th</sup> eighteen hundred and thirteen as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Lusby twenty five Dollars and fifty six cents for carrying death warrants to Frederick as per account papered and filed.
