Thursday May the 9th 1816

The Council met. Present The honourable Alexander C. Magruder James Shaw and William H. Wand.

Charles Tilden, Richard Ringgold and Jeremiah Nichols were appointed Justices of the Orphans Court for Kent County and Commission issued accordingly.

Robert Goldborough was appointed Justice of the Levy Court for Dorchester County vice W. H. Eckleton resigned and commission issued to John Williams, Thomas Emmalle Senior, Thomas Pitt, Moses W. Nesbitt, John S. McNamee, Matthias Travore, and Robert Goldborough as Justices of the Levy Court for Dorchester County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Green two hundred and eighty three Dollars and fifty cents as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that Colonel Waters deliver Colonel Richard H. Heath seventy stand of Arms for the use of the Company commanded by Captain Finley.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Gray thirty Dollars for storage of Ammunition of the 31st Regiment as per account papered & filed.
