Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Smith Quartermaster to the 21<sup>st</sup> Regiment one hundred and forty seven Dollars and ninety eight cents for supplies furnished said Regiment in eighteen hundred and fourteen as per account papered and filed with the Vouchers.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Wheeler five Dollars for making Boxes to put up Arms and Ammunition by order of General Reed as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw one hundred and eighty Dollars thirty nine and three quarter cents for stationery furnished for the use of the Executive Department as per account papered and filed.

Samuel Nicolls was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Talbot County and a new Commission issued to said County including him.
